Disaster Relief Committee Guidelines and Procedures of Operation

WHAT CONSTITUTES A DISASTER?

1. For the purpose of explanation, a disaster shall be any occurrence in which a Brother or Widow of a Brother suffers a catastrophic loss due to natural or man made causes such as wind, flood or fire. The loss must have occurred at the dwelling personally occupied by the Brother or Widow.
2. Any other loss must be determined and certified by the Grand Master.

WHAT CONSTITUTES ELIGIBILITY?

1. Any Brother who is in good and regular standing with the Grand Lodge and local Lodge shall be considered eligible to receive benefits.
2. Any Widow of a deceased Brother who has died in good standing.

TYPE AND AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE

1. All assistance shall be in the form of monetary aid.
2. No amount covered by Insurance shall be considered.

METHOD OF REPORTING

1. All reports shall be presented to this Committee on forms provided by the Committee so that there can be accurate and uniformed records maintained.
2. The necessary forms shall be forwarded to the Disaster Relief Committee, originating with the Worshipful Master of the local Lodge and then approved by the District Deputy Grand Master who shall make every effort to certify the accuracy of the request.

APPEALS

1. In the event that an individual is not satisfied with the decision of the Committee, the decision may be appealed to the Grand Master.
2. The decision of the Grand Master will be final in all matters.
